LOCATION - Metroplex Hotel and Conference Center, 1620 Motor Inn Drive, Girard, Ohio 44420. The hotel is located at the intersection of Interstate 80 and Ohio State Route 193 (exit 229 - Belmont Ave). Just 2 miles north of Youngstown, Ohio.

RESERVATIONS - For those needing over night accommodations, reservations may be made directly with the hotel. Phone 1-888-447-0606 or 330 759-0606. Be sure to mention the Alcraft Egg Show when calling to receive the show rate of \$75.00 plus tax per night (up to 4 in a room) .A continental breakfast is included in the room rate. Reservations at this rate must be made before August 24, 2009.

DIRECTIONS IF FLYING - From Pittsburgh International airport - take Rt. 60 north (just outside the gate) to Interstate 80 west to State Rt. 193 (exit 229) in Ohio. If coming from other locations, check Map Quest on our web site - bottom of the page, under Our Show.

LIMO SERVICE - Limo service is available between the Metroplex and airports in Pittsburgh, Cleveland, or Canton, Ohio at reasonable rates. Please refer to the page for the limo service in the back of this publication for complete information.

SEMINARS - Seminars will begin on Thursday, Sept. 23 and continue thru Sunday, Sept. 26. **IT IS IMPORTANT** that you make your reservations for your chosen seminars directly with the individual instructors. You must be either an exhibitor, dealer, or registered guest in order to attend any of the seminars. Badges will be handed out in the seminar rooms if you are taking classes.

REGISTERED GUESTS - If you are NOT participating as an exhibitor or dealer, you may purchase a pre-registered guest badge from Alcraft by mail in ADVANCE for \$15.00. It will be ready for you to pick up when you arrive. (Children under 12 - \$10.00). When pre-registering please include all names and addresses. If you register later than Sept. 5 or at the show the cost will be \$20.00. As a registered guest you will be entitled to attend the show two hours earlier than the general public, 8 am on both Saturday and Sunday, participate in seminars, attend the Friday night "Meet the Experts", and attend the hospitality time Saturday evening in the lobby outside the showroom. Fee non-refundable after Aug. 31.

MOONLIGHT MADNESS - Saturday evening until finished starting at 6:30 three mini projects will be taught by Helen Corrigan, Diane Macias, and Karen Farber. These may be a complete egg or something to put in, on, or under an egg. You will be learning new techniques. Class size is limited so get your reservations in early. The cost is \$33.00. Bring your RET's.

MEET THE EXPERTS - There will be free demonstrations in the foyer outside the show room on Friday evening starting at 5:05 pm under the direction of Alcraft.

HOSPITALITY TIME - Registered guests, exhibitors, and dealers are invited to attend a "Lets get acquainted" time in the lobby just outside the show room, Saturday evening beginning at 5:05. You will be greeting old friends and meeting new while enjoying finger foods. A cash bar will be available. The chocolate fountain is back! The Moonlight Madness will follow.

GENERAL PUBLIC - Tickets will be available at the door. The show will be open to the public from 10 am to 5pm on Saturday, and 10 am to 3 pm on Sunday. Entrance fee will be \$5.00, children under 12, \$3.00.

TABLE RESERVATIONS - All exhibitors and dealers are restricted to the display/sale of their own decorated, real authentic egg shells and/or egg related items. No wood, metal, plastic, or ceramic eggs. All tables will be 8' x 2½'. Set up time for dealers will be from 8 am to 5 pm on Friday, Sept. 25. Exhibitors (selling only their own decorated eggs) may set up from noon to 5 pm on Friday. All exhibits are to remain in place until 3 pm on Sunday. Tables will be assigned in order of paid registration. No tables will be reserved without payment in full. No solid back displays are permitted in the center of the showroom. Open displays are permitted up to 24" - wall space excepted. Electricity is available at no charge. You must furnish your own extension cords and table covers. No boxes or paraphernalia in the isles. Table fee is non-refundable if canceled after August 31. No one other than exhibitors or dealers may be in the show room on Friday. A concession station will be available during set-up time on Friday for exhibitors, dealers and seminar participants only.

EXHIBITOR - 8' table - \$50.00 - Display/sale of your own decorated eggs - no supplies or patterns - 1 free assistant.

DEALER - 8' table - \$95.00 - Sale of merchandise only pertaining to real, authentic egg shells and/or your own decorated eggs.

IF YOU OR YOUR FAMILY ARE DISPLAYING AS AN EXHIBITOR AND A DEALER, AND YOU ARE PURCHASING MORE THAN ONE TABLE, ALL TABLES MUST BE PURCHASED AT THE DEALER RATE.

SECURITY - All precautions will be taken to secure the show room. Neither Metroplex Hotel nor the show host will be held liable for damage or loss of goods.

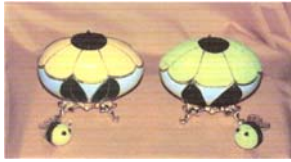
